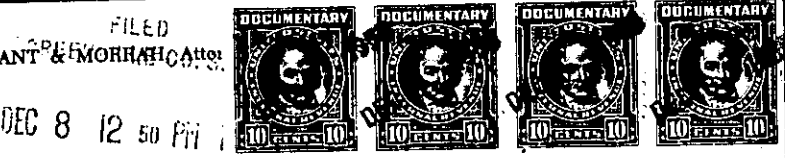

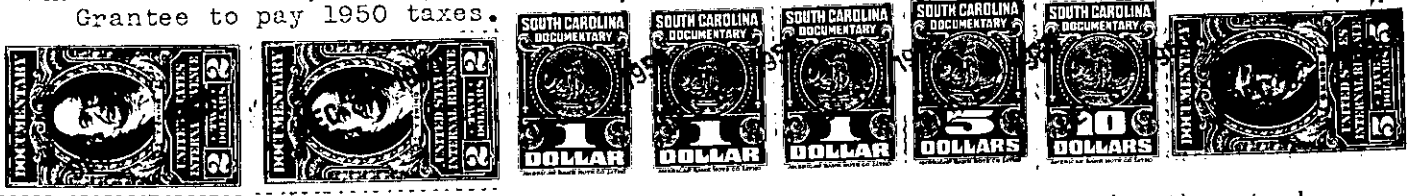
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John C. Crawford, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Orders Drive and the Northeast side of Patton Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 41 on plat of Orderest Park, made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, July 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at page 109, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by H. W. Dalton, Surveyor, November 16, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Patton Road, at joint front corner of Lots 40 and 41, and running thence with the line of Lot 40, N 70-12 E 165 feet to an iron pin; thence S 6-42 W 164.9 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Orders Drive; thence along the North side of Orders Drive, N 82-04 W 66.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Orders Drive and Patton Road, (the chord being N 53-51 W 43.9 feet) to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Patton Road; thence along the Northeast side of Patton Road, N 25-38 W 79.6 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantors by deed of Etta H. Orders, dated April 14, 1950, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book 407, at page 14.

For restrictions applicable to Orderest Park, see Deed Book 363, at page 113, and Deed Book 380, at page 475, said R. M. C. Office. Grantee to pay 1950 taxes.
