Laurens Electric Cooperative, Inc. joins in the execution of this instrument for the purpose of agreeing to its terms and releasing the above described lot from the operation of that certain lease from Riegel Textile Corporation (Ware Shoals Division) to said Laurens Electric Cooperative, Inc., dated April 28, 1950, and it does hereby agree to said terms and release.

This contract shall inure to and be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.
