leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rachel H. Snyder
for and during the term of her natural life and at her death to her
husband, James W. Snyder, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as the South 35 feet of Lot #2
as shown on plat of property of the grantor recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "B", Page 141, and
also a part of the Northern portion of Lot #1 as shown on said plat,
and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of North Parker Road (for-
merly known as Poor House Road) at Southeast corner of lot this day
conveyed to Joe Manning Snyder, and running thence with his line in a
Westerly direction 660 feet more or less to a stake in branch; thence
down and with the center line of said branch 165 feet to a stake;
thence in an Easterly direction 700 feet more or less to a stake on
the West side of said Road, which stake is 117 feet South of an iron
pin, joint front original corners of Lots 1 and 2; thence with said
Road, N. 4-45 E. 152 feet to the beginning.
