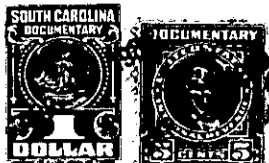

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Henry P. Willimon in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Fifty & 00/100-----(\$350.00)-----DOLLARS, in the State aforesaid,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

E. E. Mitchell, his heirs and assigns;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land being known and designated as Lot No. 191 of Pine Forrest as shown by a Plat thereof, made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer; said Lot having the courses, distances, metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin corner of Lot No. 192 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 192 S. 72-06 E. 200 feet to iron pin; thence N. 17-54 E. 60 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 190; thence with the line of said Lot No. 190 N. 72-06 W. 200 feet to iron pin on Charles Drive; thence along said Charles Drive S. 17-54 W. to point of beginning.

This deed is made subject to the easements, reservations and limitations that are set forth in the deed of the Grantor herein, to Blackinton Mills, Inc., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Book of Deeds 288 at Page 296.

That the said lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro or person of African descent. No residence to cost less than Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars shall be erected on said lot, and no residence shall be erected on said lot nearer than twenty-five (25) feet to the front line, and no residence shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
