to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto MRS. BESSIE B. BABB, her heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 127 on the Plat of College Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Princeton Avenue at the joint front corners of Lots 127 and 136, and running thence S33-10E 40.8' to an iron pin; thence N77-17E 227.9' to an iron pin on Winthrop Avenue; thence with Winthrop Avenue N19-23W 100.5' to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Winthrop Avenue and Princeton Avenue 30.8' to an iron pin on Princeton Avenue; thence with Princeton Avenue S56-50W 222.4' to the beginning corner.

The property hereby conveyed is a portion of the property conveyed to Victory Textiles (now McCall Manufacturing Company) by deed of Modern Industries of Greenville, South Carolina, dated December 20, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 369, page 71.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants and building restrictions applicable to College Heights, which are recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 297, page 218, and Deed Book 393, page 429.
