of Alfred Taylor prepared by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, in January 1913, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, towit: BEGINNING at a stake on the National Highway and running thence N. 18 W. 150 feet to stake; thence N. 71-45 E. 25 feet to stake; thence S. 18 E. 150 feet to stake on National Highway; thence along said Highway, S. 71-45 W. 25 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by C. A. Henson by deed dated January 28, 1931 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 157, at page 440.

ALSO: "That certain driveway strip 4 feet 7 inches wide and 150 feet long, which adjoins the above described lot on the west side. Said driveway is the same conveyed to me by S. B. D. Jones by his deed dated February 15, 1930 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 161, at page 388.
