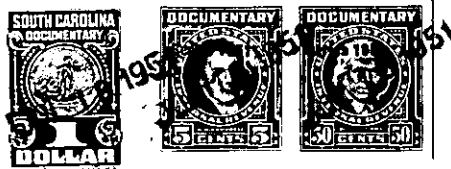
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Francis Singleton, her heirs and assigns, forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 7, according to a plat of property of P. L. Bruce, prepared by R. K. Campbell, recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 171 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At a point on the Northwest side of a driveway, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, and running thence along the Northwest side of said driveway, S. 34-55 W. 60 feet to a point, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, N. 55-05 W. 140 feet to a point, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7, 8, 20 and 21; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 7 and 21, N. 34-55 E. 60 feet to a point, joint corner of Lots Nos. 6, 7, 21 and 22; thence along the joint lines of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, S. 55-05 E. 140 feet to the point of beginning.
