BEGINNING At a point on the North side of West Coffee Street in a 12" brick wall which point is located 59 feet  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the Northeast corner of Coffee and Richardson Streets and running thence N. 21-44 E. 65 feet to a point on an alley; thence with said alley S. 83-30 E. 21 feet 6 inches to a point on said alley which point is the center of a 17 inch brick wall; thence with the center of said brick wall S. 21-44 W. 70 feet 4 inches to a point on the North side of West Coffee Street in center of said wall; thence with the North side of said Coffee Street N. 69-10 W. 20 feet 10 inches to the path of beginning.
