BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of the Woodruff Road and a County Road and running thence along said County Road, N. 15-11 E. 899 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 5-52 W. 102.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23-57 W. 97.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 68-40 E. 163 feet to an iron pin; thence 13 feet, more or less, to point in the center of a branch; thence from said iron pin and following traverse lines with the center of the branch as the line, the following courses and distances, to-wit: S. 15-27 E. 68.5 feet; S. 2-24 W. 240.5 feet; S. 9-38 W. 237.5 feet; S. 23-40 W. 629.1 feet to a point on the northern side of the Woodruff Road where said branch intersects with said road; thence S. 87-51 W. 69.7 fact to iron pin at the point of beginning.
