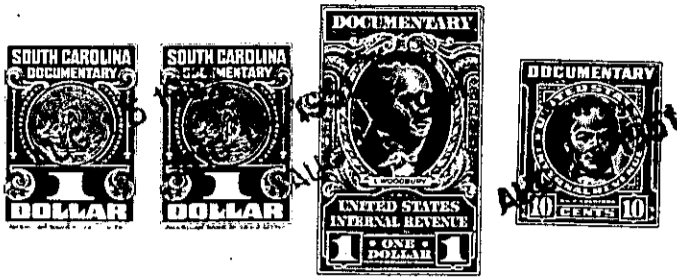

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, T. C. Shealy and
Nettie V. Shealy
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Seven Hundred, Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars

in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by George Williams and Etta May W. Williams
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Williams and Etta May W.
Williams, their heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, and now within the corporate limits of the City
of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 53 and 54, of
Block E, of "Stone Estates", according to a plat thereof prepared by
C.M. Furman, Jr., October, 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C. office
for Greenville County in Plat Book G, page 292, and having, according
to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the
intersection of the Camp Road with Druid Street, and running thence
along the south side of the Camp Road, N. 74-30 E. 54 feet to an iron
pin at the corner of Lot No. 55; thence along the line of that lot,
S. 11-22 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 24; thence
along the line of that lot, S. 74-30 W. 54 feet to an iron pin on the
east side of Druid Street; thence along the east side of Druid Street,
N. 11-22 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

Anderson, Laura E. Anderson, Burton S. Anderson and Hugh T. Anderson
from Ida E. Anderson who died intestate on December 30, 1945, her
