Crumley and Evelyn F. Crumley, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that tract or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Arlington Road, being known and designated as lot 24, Block E, as shown on a plat of Paris Heights, recorded in Plat Book i at Page 65, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey prepared by J.C. Hill, July 16, 1951, as follows:
