to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles W. Cook, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue, within the new City limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 280, according to plat of Pleasant Valley, prepared by Dalton & Neves, April, 1946, as revised through February, 1950, and as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P, page 92, and according to further plat of Lot No. 280, recorded in said Office in Plat Book T, page 224, and having, according to said plats, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue, in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Prancer Avenue with Panama Avenue, thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet along Panama Avenue to an iron pin at the common corner of Lots Nos. 280 and 223 on the Western side of Panama Avenue; thence S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner Lots Nos. 280 and 281; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner Lots Nos. 280 and 281 on the Northern side of Prancer Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Prancer Avenue with Panama Avenue, the point of beginning.

The above-described property is subject to restrictions recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deeds Vol. 301, page 60, as amended in Deeds Vol. 435, page 223.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
