

DISCUSSION OF PARTNERSHIP

This instrument was made this 16th day of August, 1951, between J. R. Rickey and James M. Holcombe of Greenville, South Carolina.

WHEREAS, articles of co-partnership were entered into on the 16th day of November, 1950, by and between J. R. Rickey and James M. Holcombe, and,

WHEREAS, the said J. R. Rickey and James M. Holcombe have mutually agreed to dissolve said partnership by mutual consent:

IT IS AGreed THAT all the assets of any kind and nature, all outstanding accounts, office fixtures, etc., and the good will of said business shall be the property of said J. R. Rickey for his own use and behoof forever. The said J. R. Rickey agrees to assume and pay all liabilities of said co-partnership, and for and in consideration of all interests in said co-partnership heretofore owned by the said James M. Holcombe, the said J. R. Rickey hereby agrees to pay to said James M. Holcombe, Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) dollars, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. IT IS SO AGREED, the parties hereto have hereunto set their hands and seals, the day and year first above written.
