and other valuable considerations to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto H. P. Asay, Jr. and T. G. Crymes, Jr., their heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 190, Pleasant Valley Subdivision, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. K. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P, page 114, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Potomac Avenue, joint front corner Lots Nos. 189 and 190, said iron pin being 370 feet in a Westerly direction from an iron pin in the Northwest intersection of Potomac Avenue and Panama Avenue, and running thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 189, 190, 107 and 108; thence S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 190, 191, 106 and 107; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Potomac Avenue, joint front corner Lots Nos. 190 and 191; thence along the North side of Potomac Avenue N. 89-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The herein named grantees are to pay 1951 taxes on the above-described property.

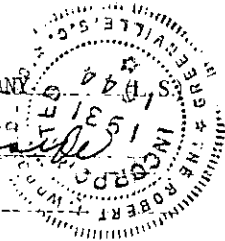
