

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

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WHEREAS: A Resolution was duly ladopted Son April 19th, 1951, by the Board of Trustees of Allison School District #12 (C), and approved and ratified by the Greenville County Board of Education, under the terms of which the Trustees arranged with J. D. Poag, Attorney, for Gayley Mills Ccorporation for the relocation of Allison School and disposition of the present school building, and

WHEREAS: It now appears that Allison School District #12 (C) will be consolidated with another school District and that there will be no further need for a school building in District #12 (C), so that it becomes unnecessary for Gayley Mills Corporation to donate a new school site, and purchase the same from the Trustees in accordance with the terms of the Resolution but that the purpose of the parties can be accomplished in an entirely satisfactory manner by the Mills purchasing the land on which the school was formerly located,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, paid by J. D. Poag, Attorney, to S. C. Moody, Zachary Moses, and Dewey O. Leslie, Trustees of Allison School District #12 (C), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, which is agreed to be the fair, market price for the land involved, the said Board does hereby authorize, empower, and direct J. D. Todd, County Attorney of Greenville County to deliver to J. D. Poag, Attorney, the deed to the school property deposited with him, and the Board does further specifically release and forever discharge J. D. Poag, Attorney, individually, and Gayley Mills Corporation from donating, conveying or purchasing a tract of land to or from, Allison School District #12 (C) for school or any other purposes.
