THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 14th day of November, 1951, by and between GREENVILLE AND NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the first part, hereinafter called the "Railway Company", and GREATER GREENVILLE SEWER DISTRICT, a body corporate and politic organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the second part, hereinafter called the "Sewer District",

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Sewer District proposes to construct a sewer line from a point near the property line of the Southern Railway Company and the Railway Company where the Southern Railway Company has an overhead crossing of the street extending from River Street to Whitmire Street, crossing the property of the Railway Company for a distance of six feet, as shown by a red line on the attached print, thence crossing said road to a point near the turn table of the Railway Company, thence across the property of the Railway Company for a distance of 143.2 feet to said road, as shown by a black line on the attached print, thence with said road in an easterly direction to the property of the Railway Company, thence crossing the property of the Railway Company for a distance of 73.5 feet to Reedy River, as shown by a yellow line on the attached print, which print is made a part of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the agreements on the part of the Sewer District to be performed as hereinafter set out, the parties have agreed and do agree as follows:

1. The Railway Company, so far as it is authorized, does hereby grant and convey unto the Sewer District, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, maintain and operate said sewer line referred to, being a 42" sewer line.
2. The Sewer District agrees that in the construction of said sewer line over the land of the Railway Company, as indicated on the
