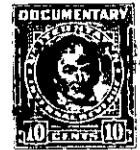

Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, John Edward Bridges and Kathleen G. Bridges in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ....Three Thousand and no/100....(\$3,000.00) DOLLARS, and the assumption of the mortgage hereinbelow described, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jackson B. Murphree and his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Yown Road and known and designated as Lot No. 144 of Camilla Park #4, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 117, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Yown Road, joint corner of Lots Nos. 143 and 144, and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 7-44 W. 690.2 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots: thence S. 69-13 W. 165 feet to an iron pin: thence S. 12-55 E. 678 feet to an iron pin in the line of Yown Road: and thence along the northern side of Yown Road N. 70-44 E. 101 feet to the point of beginning, being the same lot of land conveyed to the grantors herein by J. V. Eberhardt by deed dated September 22, 1951, deed to be recorded. This conveyance is subject to the restrictions contained in the deed from the First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Administrator, to B. L. Carter and Annie Bell T. Carter recorded in Book 291, Page 313.

The grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay the unpaid balance on a mortgage to the Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association, said unpaid balance being Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars.

The grantors agree to pay the 1951 taxes.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
