M. C. of the County of Greenville in the State of So. Carolina, in Liber 424 of Deed Book at page 131 covering property situated on Laurens Road and Ackley Street near the City of Greenville, South Carolina,

TOGETHER with all the right, title and interest of the Assignor in and to said premises and the improvements and structures thereon,

TOGETHER also with all the rights, rights of renewal, benefits, privileges and immunities of the Assignor in, to and under said lease,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the Assignee, its successors and assigns for all the rest of the term mentioned in said Lease and any renewal period thereof, subject however to all the terms, covenants, conditions and provisos contained in said Lease.
