of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$3500.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Raymond O. Parris

All that certain lot or parcel of land in C'Neal Township, said County
and State, on the N/S of the Bright Road, about one mile from Graer, con-
taining a dwelling house, and beginning in the center of bridge across
Morrow branch; thence N 6-30 W 354 feet to bend in branch; thence N 11-45
W 183.4 feet to stake on line of #3; thence N 80-00 W 186 feet to stake on
N. E. Bright's line; thence with his line S 38-00 W 611.8 feet to center
of Bright road; thence therewith S 77-50 E 394.5 feet to bend in road;
thence N 89-50 E 178.5 feet to center of bridge, beginning corner, and
being tract #5 of the J. E. Burnett Estate, containing four and 55/100
(4.55) acres, more or less, and conveyed to Haskell V. Cox by deed of J. O.
