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to a rock corner; thence along Scoggins line to the rock corner; thence along Scoggins line southeast to a rock corner; thence southeast along Scoggins line to the Trammell land; thence southeast to a chestnut oak corner; thence south to the beginning chestnut stump, containing 150 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands now or formerly owned by C. A. Fowler, Scoggins and others, and being the same conveyed to us by E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, by deed dated October 24, 1945, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 282, page 95.

(6) ALSO that other tract of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, about 19 miles from the City of Greenville, two miles east of the Buncombe Road, containing approximately 100 acres, bounded on the north by lands now or formerly owned by J. P. Pittman and Emma Choice; on the northeast by lands now or formerly owned by W. F. Pittman; on the east by lands now or formerly owned by T. A. Honour; on the southeast and south by lands now or formerly owned by Rufus Allen; on the southwest by lands now or formerly owned by Dublin; on the west by lands of Walker Choice; on the northwest by lands of Walker Choice and Emma Choice, being the same conveyed to us by Greer Oil Mill and Feed Company by deed dated December 20, 1950, and recorded in Book 426, page 9.

(7) ALSO that other tract of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, (sometimes incorrectly said to be in "Glassy Mountain Township"), on branch waters of Mush Creek, Waters of South Tyger River, containing 151.90 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor:

BEGINNING at a stone corner near Bridge Road, corner Morgan's land, and running thence with Road S. 71-00 W. 322 feet to bend; thence S. 61-30 W. 264 feet to bend; thence S. 77-15 W. 119 feet; thence S. 13-45 W. 968 feet to a stake xom; thence N. 87-00 W. 936 feet to stone (chestnut gone); thence S. 7-40 E. 1234 feet to stake OM; thence S. 8-17 E. 1,525 feet to stone; thence S. 86-36 E. 666 feet to stone OM (R. O. Gone); thence N. 35-14 E. 2888 feet to stone; thence N. 44-40 W. 66 feet to stone; thence N. 15-00 E. 772 feet to W. O. XOM; thence N. 48-30 W. 665 feet to iron pin; and thence N. 54-30 W. 670 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described tract of land was conveyed to us by William McAbee by deed dated June 12th, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 349, page 455.

RESERVING, HOWEVER, from this conveyance all merchantable timber (that is to say, all timber measuring six inches in diameter one foot from the ground) from the six tracts of land first above described and numbered (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and (6), with the right of ingress and egress reserved to the grantors, for a period of six months from this date, to cut, saw and remove said timber from the said premises.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
