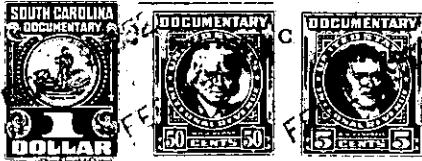

Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Paul S. Craig and Theresa Craig, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or strip of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the Westerly one-half of Lot No. 16, Air Base Highlands, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book Z, page 195, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of an unnamed street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16, and running thence N. 0-51 W. 150 feet to an iron pin, common corner Lots Nos. 13, 14, 15 and 16; thence S. 89-15 E. 25 feet to a point in the center of the rear line of Lot No. 16; thence through the center of Lot No. 16, S. 0-51 E. 150 feet to a point on the North side of an unnamed street; thence along the North side of the said unnamed street, N. 89-15 W. 25 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The above named grantees to pay the 1952 taxes on the above described property.
