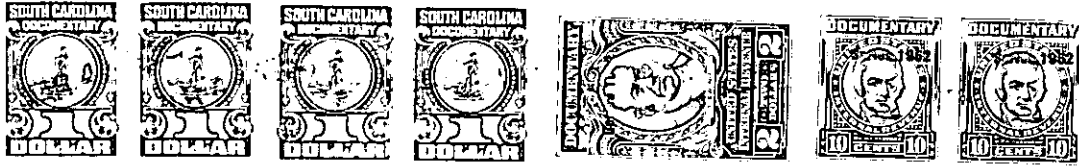

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. L. Robertson, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the westerly side of Mitchell Avenue, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, Section F, Croftstone Acres, and having, according to a revision of a portion of Croftstone Acres, plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, August 9, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Mitchell Avenue, joint front corner Lots Nos. 11 and 12, Section F, said pin being 213.1 feet in a southerly direction from an iron pin in the southwest intersection of Olwell Avenue and Mitchell Avenue and running thence S. 52-49 W. 185.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence S. 29-38 E. 51.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence N. 64-42 E. 183.7 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Mitchell Avenue; thence along the westerly side of Mitchell Avenue N. 28-34 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
