of South Carolina. located on Paris Mountain and being known and designated as Tract No. 13, containing One (1) Acre, more or less, according to a Survey made by W. J. Riddle, January 1952 of the property of E. D. Harrell, Jr. and L. G. Causey and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on an Un-Named Road at the front corner of Lots 14 and 13 and running thence North 15-45 East 313 feet to an iron pin in center of branch; thence with the branch as the line, North 65 West 130.7 feet to an iron pin in branch; thence South 15-45 West 300 feet to an iron pin in Un-named Road; running thence along said Un-named Road, South 81-31 East 130 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This property is sold subject to the following restrictons:

- 1. This property is to be sold and used for residential purposes only.
- 2. No dwelling shall be erected on said tract costing less than \$12,000.00.
- All sewerage disposal shall be by septic tanks or sewer meeting the approval of the State Board of Health or by Municipal sewerage system.
- 4. No building shall be constructed on any lot nearer to the front line than 40 feet; nor closer to any side line than 10 feet.
- 5. No trailer, basement, tents, shacks, garages, barns or other outbuildings shall be used on said property as a residence.
- 6. No animals, other than household pets and a reasonable number of chickens for home use shall be kept on said premises.
- 7. No outbuilding for the housing of any pet or chickens shall be constructed nearer than 25 feet to any side line of any lot.
- 8. This tract shall not be re-cut so as to permit the erection of any residence on a lot having less than 130 feet frontage on said Unnamed Road.
