JUDGMENT RE DECLARATION OF TAKING

Civil No. 1175

This day comes the petitioner in the above entitled cause, the United States of America, by John C. Williams, Esq., United States Attorney, and Walter H. Sims, Special Attorney, Department of Justice, and moves the court to enter a judgment on the declaration of taking filed in the above cause on April 23, 1952, and upon consideration thereof and of the condemnation petition and amendments therof filed herein, said declaration of taking, the statutes in such cases made and provided, and it appearing to the satisfaction of this court;

First, That the United States of America is entitled to acquire property by eminent domain for the purposes as set out and prayed for in said petition as amended;

Second, That a petition in condemnation as amended was filed at the request of the Secretary of the Air Force, the authority empowered by law to acquire the lands described in said petition as amended and also under authority of the Attorney General of the United States;

Third, That the said petition as amended and declaration of taking state the authority under which and the public use for which said lands were taken, that the Secretary of the Air Force is the person duly authorized and empowered by law to acquire lands such as are described in the petition as amended for the purpose of providing a training site for use of the Department of the Air Force and for
