30th day of August, 1952, with the privilege of extending this option until the second day of May, 1953, upon the payment by the said Spartan Radiocasting Company to us of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, cash, which amount shall be credited upon the purchase price of the property hereinbefore described when and if this sale is consummated.

It is further understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that this sale shall be subject to the passing of title to said lands and premises by reputable attorneys on or before the 30th day of August, 1952, unless this option shall be extended as hereinbefore set forth.

It is further understood and agreed between the parties hereto that this option is made subject to the following conditions, to-wit:

1. That Mr. J. R. Weatherbee of Putney, Georgia, the former owner of the above described property, now the mortgages of said property will have to approve this option and release his lien, and convey his interest in the above described property to the Spartan Radiocasting Company upon payment of \$5,000.00; said payment to be made to J.
