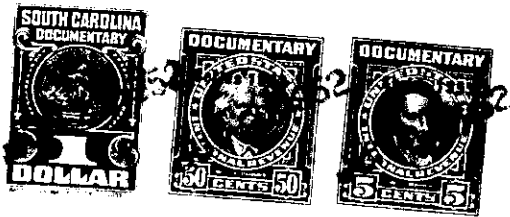

by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James William Hopkins, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated and being in the County and State aforesaid on the Greenville and Abbeville Road, beginning on a stone and thence N. 1 3/4 E. 3.19 to a stone; thence S. 72 3/4 W. 3.17 to a stone; thence S. 1 3/4 W. 3.19 to a stone; thence N. 72 3/4 E. 3.17 to the beginning corner. Said lot of land is bounded by lands of Lesley and lands of Mrs. S. H. Paxton, the grantor herein, and is the same lot of land conveyed to me by Edgar Boyce by deed dated May 1, 1934, of record in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Vol. 175, at page 144. Said lot of land contains one acre, more or less.
