2. That the easements for ingress and egress which were acquired or reserved in favor of either of the undersigned parties hereto, in the deed of John F. Chandler to C. E. Robinson, Jr. and R. M. Gaffney and in the deed of S. & M. Real Estate Company, Inc. to John F. Chandler recorded in Deed Book 456, Page 535 and Deed Book 448, Page 533, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., are hereby abandoned and each of the parties hereto release and relinquish any right or interest that either of them may have to use all or any portion of the strips or parcels of land described in said deed as a means of ingress and egress.
