HENDRIX in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE AND 10/100 (\$1.00) DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said LOUIS MONROE, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All our interest in a tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 7 acres, more or less, and being known as Tract No. 5 of property of W. J. Monroe Estate, as shown on plat by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, May, 1952, and recorded in Deed Book CC, page 87, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone and iron pin, and running thence N. 44-30-00 E. 100.00 feet to an iron pin; thence with Tract No. 2, N. 22-10-00 E. 100.00 feet to an iron pin; thence with Tract No. 4, S. 52-57 E. 593 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-05 W. 515 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The above is a part of the land conveyed to W. J. Monroe by deed recorded in Deed Book 393, Page 301, and he died intestate in March, 1950, leaving as his sole heirs, his widow, Mollie McCall Monroe, and children, Executors and grantee herein, and this Deed is executed in partition of his estate.

The Grantors give to the grantee a right-of-way across Tract No. 1 and so much of Tract No. 2 or Tract No. 4 as may be necessary as a means of ingress and egress to Tract No. 3 not to exceed 12 feet in width.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
