ALL That piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining the southern line of Lot No. 9 and the southern line of the western one-half of Lot No. 10 (said Lots Nos. 9 and 10 being shown on plat of property of Cleveland Forest recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book M, Page 137), having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
