CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, EDGAR M. NORRIS AND WESLEY M. WALKER

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 22nd day of October, 1952, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE TELEVISION COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To carry on, in all or any of the several branches, the business of radio broadcasting (including the carrying on of television broadcasting), and to construct, lease, own, operate, and maintain, and shall be authorized to serve the public in any, and all, ways in connection therewith;

To apply for, receive, use, and enjoy any and all licenses, permits and grants necessary, appropriate or convenient for the erection, construction, maintenance and operation of radio and television broadcasting stations, and to construct, lease, own, operate, and maintain, and shall be authorized to serve the public in any, and all, ways in connection therewith;

To contract with respect to, purchase, lease, use, and enjoy, and otherwise deal in and with real estate, including radio and television broadcasting stations, and to construct, lease, own, operate, and maintain, and shall be authorized to serve the public in any, and all, ways in connection therewith;

To transmit, disseminate, and otherwise deal in and with aural and visual images, alone or in combination with each other, by means of electric energy and by any other means or in any way now or hereafter discovered;

To manufacture, acquire, construct, lease, use, and otherwise deal in, and to sell, lease, dispose of, and otherwise deal in and with, radio and television sets, apparatus, systems, and accessories, and to construct, lease, own, operate, and maintain, and shall be authorized to serve the public in any, and all, ways in connection therewith;

To create and produce radio and television (including radio and television broadcasting) programs, and to construct, lease, own, operate, and maintain, and shall be authorized to serve the public in any, and all, ways in connection therewith;

To hire, employ, contract with, furnish and otherwise deal in and with business with relation to speaking, musicians, actors, dancers, singers and all other types and kinds of artists, entertainers, performers and attractions, for any and all purposes; and to give, and cause to be given, performances, exhibitions and entertainments of all kinds;

To manage, direct, book, represent and, as agents or otherwise, to act for and on behalf of lecturers, speakers, vocal and instrumental musicians, conductors, actors, dancers, writers, composers, and all other types and kinds of artists, performers and attractions;

To buy, lease and otherwise acquire, to own and operate, and to sell, let, and otherwise dispose of studios, theaters, and other places of amusement, entertainment or public gathering; and to give, and cause to be given, entertainments and performances of any and all kinds therein;

To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, to maintain and operate, and to sell, let and otherwise dispose of radio broadcasting, television, sound recording, moving picture studios, machines, plants, and factories of all kinds and descriptions; to invent, manufacture, buy, lease and otherwise acquire, to maintain and operate, and to let, sell, and otherwise dispose of any and all machinery, instruments, implements and devices of any and every kind and nature pertaining to the same; and to produce, reproduce, disseminate, and record aural and visual images, alone or in combination with each other, by means of films, records and other devices of whatsoever name or nature, whether now or hereafter known or discovered;
