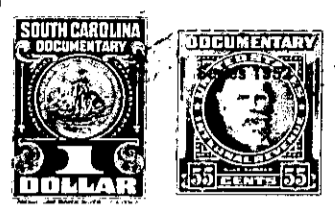

Gordon Belcher, constituting and being the Board of Deacons of Brushy
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. H. Jones, J. I. Hightower, Edward Holtzclaw, John Boling, I. C. McCoy, J. I. Burns, Carol Runion, Robert Collins, and Gordon Belcher, constituting and being the Board of Deacons of Brushy Creek Baptist Church as Trustees, and their successors and assigns, forever:

All that parcel, or tract of land, situate, lying and being South of the Old Spartanburg Road, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, S. C. and having according to a survey made by C. O. Riddle, October, 1952, the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at a stone at the Southeast corner of property of the Brushy Creek Baptist Church and running thence along the line of the church property S. 88-50 W. 416 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of other property of the Grantor, S. 34-58 E. 619.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along Holtzclaw property N. 11-15 E. 99.8 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the Holtzclaw line N. 10-35 E. 404.6 feet to a white oak; thence still along the Holtzclaw line N. 58-07 W. 38 feet to the beginning corner and contains 2.65 acres.
