in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

E. J. Pittman, R.A. Shelton, Ernest R. Dodson and Daniel Durham, as Trustees of Woodlawn Baptist Church,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of West Greenville and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Woodlawn Avenue, same being the rear line of Lot No. 52 hereinafter fully described, and running thence S. 74-26 W. 57.7 feet to a point, also corner of the rear line of said lot; thence S. 15-20 E. 40 feet to a stake in the line of Lot 52; thence N. 74-26 E. approximately 58.5 feet to a stake on Woodlawn Avenue; thence with Woodlawn Avenue N. 16-05 W. 40 feet to the point and place of beginning, and being the rear portion of Lot 52 as shown on a Plat of "Donwood", said plat recorded in Plat Book "A", page 463, and being a portion of the same lot conveyed to J. P. Thompson by M. H. Shuman as Executor of the last will of B. M. Shuman, deceased, deed recorded in Book 163, page 405, R. M.C. Office for Greenville County. Reference to the said deed and plat are hereby craved for a more specific and complete description of the said lot herein conveyed.

This property was conveyed to W. H. Edwards, C. H. Wike and Joe Moon, as Trustees of the "Bible Baptist Church" by Fred M. Thompson, as Executor and Trustee, by deed dated October 14, 1947, and recorded in the R. M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 320, page 491. Subsequently on September 16, 1951, the Church was called in conference and all members being present voted to change the name from "Bible Baptist Church" to "Woodlawn Baptist Church", and this deed is executed for the purpose of correcting the record and establishing the property in the name of "Woodlawn Baptist Church".
