Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Roy Dryman, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) - - - - - DOLLARS, and the assumption of mortgage hereinafter more specifically set forth, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. E. Howard, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the western side of Geer Highway in, or near, the Town of Travelers Rest, and, according to survey made by T. T. Dill, Surveyor, in April 1947, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Old White Horse Road (abandoned), corner of property now, or formerly, owned by Mrs. Montgomery, and running thence with the line of said property, S. 67-30 W. 246 feet to an iron pin, corner of property formerly owned by Coleman, later by McDowell; thence with the line of said property last mentioned, N. 38-30 W. 83 feet to an iron pin; thence, continuing with the line of said property, N. 53-30 E. 236.4 feet to an iron pin on Geer Highway; thence with the western side of Geer Highway, S. 38-30 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to me by Nannie E. Montgomery, now Nannie E. Powell, by deed dated August 12, 1952, recorded in Vol. 460 at page 520 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

As a part of the consideration hereinabove expressed, Grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay balance owing to the extent of \$1690.00, on that certain Note and Mortgage executed to the Peoples National Bank, of Greenville, S. C., by Nannie E. Montgomery, now Nannie E. Powell, for the original sum of \$1750.00, dated July 24, 1952, said mortgage recorded in Vol. 535 at page 417 in R. M. C. office. The Grantor herein is to pay all taxes for the year 1952.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
