ing twelve and nine-tenth acres ( 12.9) more or less ; and being  
that certain piece, parcel or lot of land sold by the Bank of  
Piedmont, Piedmont, S.C.

" Beginning at a point in center of road leading from Pied-  
mont- Bessie road towards Greenville S.C. at corner of V.P.Jenkins  
lot ( sold ) and running thence along said Jenkins line N-43-W- 21.60  
to a stone ; thence S- 48-3/4- W 6.00 to a stone on line of Bank of
