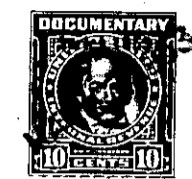
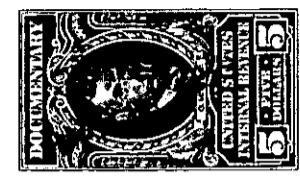

All those certain lots in the City of Greenville, just off the  
Laurens Road, on Brunson Street(formerly known as Grace Street),  
County of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated  
as lots numbers 46 and 47 of the E. G. Glenn property as shown on  
a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., recorded in Plat Book F, Page  
148. Described as a whole the two lots are as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Brunson  
Street and running thence along the rear line of lots numbers 25 and  
26 N. 55-41 W. 79.6 feet to iron pin at corner of lot number 27;  
thence along the rear line of lots numbers 27 and 28 N. 47-38 W. 131.1  
feet to iron pin at the rear corner of lots numbers 28, 46 and 47  
thence along the rear line of lot number 47 S. 47-45 W. 57 feet  
to iron pin at rear corner of lot number 48; thence along the line  
of lots numbers 47 and 48 S. 28-22 E. 180.2 feet to iron pin on the  
northwestern side of Brunson Street; thence along northwest side of  
that street N. 61-38 E. 135.7 feet to the beginning corner and being  
the same lots conveyed to Dorothy W. Scott and Luther H. Scott, Jr.  
by J. E. Brunson by deed dated September 25, 1950, recorded in Deed  
Book 419, Page 481.
