To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Eden Holiness Baptist Association, a Corporation, et al,

on or about the 16th day of December in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-two exhibited their  
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against  
Rev. Roy Bagwell, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the 23rd day of March 1953,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Eden Holiness Baptist Association, a Corporation  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said Eden Holiness Baptist Association, a Corporation

"An undivided one-half interest in and to all that piece, parcel or  
lot of land in Greenville Township, in Greenville County, State of South  
Carolina, known as Lot No. 6, Block G of plat of the property of the River-  
side Land Company, having frontage on Cedar Lane Road of 74 feet, running  
back 126 feet on one side and 125 feet on Sumpter Street, and 74 feet in the  
rear. Said lot at corner of Cedar Lane Road or Avenue and Sumpter Street."

action and is without any monetary consideration.
