

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto R. E. McCall, his heirs and assigns, forever.

All that lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the southwest side of Mayo Drive and the northwest side of Crosby Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot No. 173 on plat of Paramount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, July 1949, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "W", at Page 57, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Mayo Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 173 and 174 and running thence with the line of Lot 174, S. 64-0 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-0 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Crosby Circle; thence with the northwest side of Crosby Circle, N. 64-0 E. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Crosby Circle and Mayo Drive, (the chord being N. 19-0 E. 35.4 feet) to an iron pin on the southwest side of Mayo Drive; thence with the southwest side of Mayo Drive, N. 26-0 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
