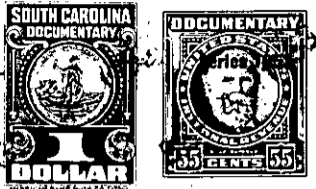

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. G. Huff

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, GREENVILLE
County, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of P. L. Huff on the north
and east, S. E. Harrison on the south and Alice Durant on the west,
containing two acres, more or less, and beginning at an old stone by
Harrison, Huff and Durant and running thence N. 11 3/4 E. 6.38 to
iron pin; thence N. 65 1/2 W. 13.175 to iron pin; thence S. 11 3/4
W. 6.38 to iron pin on old Harrison line; thence S. 65 1/2 E. 3.175
to the beginning corner, and being the same parcel of land conveyed
to S. E. Harrison and others as trustees of the Hopewell School District
