That we, D. T. Moree and Ethel Moree in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One & 00/100 (\$1.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

M. W. FORE, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 57 of a subdivision known as Avalon Estates, as shown by a plat thereof, dated June, 1948, recorded in the R. M. c. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in P at Book "S", at Page 89 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Crestview Drive at joint front corners of Lots No. 56 and 57 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 56, N. 57-10 E. 164.7 feet to iron pin in line of Lot No. 84; thence along the line of said Lot No. 84, S. 52-50 E. 35 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 58; thence along the line of said Lot No. 58, S. 40-0 W. 173.5 feet to iron pin on Crestview Drive; thence with the said Crestview Drive N. 40-25 W. 85 feet to iron pin at point of beginning.

THAT the said lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro or person of African descent. No residence or business costing less than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, shall be erected on said lot, and no residence or building shall be erected on said lot nearer than twenty-five (25) feet to the front line, and no residence or business shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage. No business building shall be erected on any lot other than lots fronting on U. S. Route No. 25.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
