to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. S. Sanders and his heirs and assigns forever

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the South side of Mill Street near Poe Mill and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on Plat of property of Stanley Batson and P. B. L. Cauley recorded in Plat Book N, page 193, in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and same is a nortion, of Lot No. 1 of the H. P. Hammett Estate as shown on plat recorded in Deed Book "HHH", page 835, also see Plat recorded in Plat Book "C", page 69 and having the following metes and bounds according to survey by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, on Pay 20, 1946:

BEGINNING at a post on the south side of Mill Street and running thence S. 21-45 W., 98.7 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 1; thence with line of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, W. 68-15, W. 165.8 feet more or less, to a stake in the center line of the southern line of said railway right of way N. 38-30 E., 98.6 feet to a stake, thence S. 68-15 E., 138 feet to the beginning point on Will Street. The last course and distance was partially along Will treet and partially along the Southern Railway right of way.

It is expressly understood that the warranty contained in this deed does not in any wise apply to any portion of the above described lot conveyed by the right of way of the Southern Railway Company. This is the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor herein by R. C. Cudd by deed dated July 16, 1953, recorded in Leed Book 482 at page 99, and is shown on the County Block Book as 153-2-18.
