to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JACK BURDETTE, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land situate on the northwest side of Lady Marian Lane, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., shown as Lot No. 117 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "GG", at Pages 2 and 3, (also recorded in Plat Book "BB", at Pages 30 and 31), and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

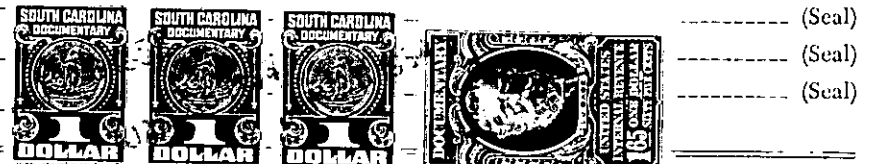
