in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One thousand five hundred twenty-five and no/100 (\$ 1,525.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by William T. Rainey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William T. Rainey and his Heirs and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina being the abandoned Colored School No. 9-E and bounded by lands of Grantee, J.H. Rainey, Ethel Hagood, and F. A. Dickens and Containing Two Acres, more or less, and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin corner on south side of old road, the corner of Hagood and Dickens lands, and running thence N. 28-45 W. 264 feet to iron pin corner of Grantees land on Dickens' line; thence S 78-45 E. 231 feet to iron pin by old road at Chestnut Oak; thence S. 25-00 E. 323.4 feet to iron pin in State Secondary Road; thence N. 78-45 W. 503.5 feet to beginning corner.
