to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

GEORGE T. MORRIS and MAUDE P. MORRIS, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 49 of a subdivision known as Section "A", of Englewood Estates, as shown by a Plat thereof, dated October, 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book, "Y", at Page 140.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Beaumont Drive at joint front corners of Lots No. 48 and 49 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 48, N. 87-30 W. 200 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 61; thence along the rear line of said Lot No. 61, S. 2-30 W. 100 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 50; thence along the line of said Lot No. 50, S. 87-30 E. 200 feet to iron pin on Beaumont Drive; thence with the said Beaumont Drive, N. 2-30 E. 100 feet to iron pin at point of beginning.

THIS property is subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. No house is to be erected costing less than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars.
2. No house is to be built closer than fifty (50) feet to the street.
3. No temporary house is to be erected on said lot.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
