Office in Plat Book "EE" at pages 2 and 3, and a question has arisen as to this restriction and its possible effect on applications for loans by owners of this property and purchasers of lots in said subdivision and it now appears advisable and to the best interest of all persons owning property in this subdivision to eliminate and cancel this restriction;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, A. L. Beam, Grantor in the original deed above referred to, and Lide L. Richbourg and Lila M. Richbourg, Grantees in said deed, and the undersigned being all persons having any interest in said tract of land or the lots or property in said subdivision, in consideration of the premises and the benefits accruing to us have expressly waived and relinquished and do hereby expressly waive and relinquish any and all rights under such restriction and expressly agree and consent that said restriction shall be released, eliminated and cancelled so that it shall not apply to or affect the said tract of land containing 43.43 acres above referred to or any part of the same or any of the lots in "Morningside" Subdivision.
