

G. All sewer disposal shall be by septic tanks, meeting the approval of the State Board of Health, until such time as public sewage disposal is made available.

The property affected by the above mentioned restrictions is encumbered by a mortgage given by C. P. Rhodes (now deceased) to Thaddeus B. Reeves (now deceased) in the amount of \$3,300.00 dated September 27, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 352, at page 300, and The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as one of the Executors under the will of Thaddeus B. Reeves, deceased, is joining in the execution of this instrument for the sole purpose of showing its consent to Mrs. Nora Ellen S. Rhodes imposing the above restrictions on her interest in the property mentioned and described above.
