

Said Seller for itself, its successors and assigns, hereby expressly reserves and retains:

(a) Title to all appliances, apparatus, equipment and property constituting any part of the telephone, water and fire protection utilities, or which may be used in connection with the operation of such utilities now located on the premises herein conveyed, of any and every kind, except the water lines on said premises running from a main line to any building on said premises; and

(b) A perpetual easement in favor of said Seller, its grantees, successors or assigns to locate and relocate on said premises electrical, water, sewer, fire protection, gas and/or telephone facilities, including the erection of towers and poles, the stringing of wires, the installation of gas, water, and sewer mains and lines, hydrants, meters, and all other apparatus or equipment necessary or desirable in connection with the installation and operation of any or all of said utilities, and also a perpetual easement to go upon and across said property hereby conveyed, for the purpose of maintaining, operating, repairing and/or relocating any or all electrical, water, sewer, fire protection, gas, garbage and telephone facilities now located or which may hereafter be located upon or across said property hereby conveyed, with the right of ingress and egress at all times for any and all of said purposes.

Said described lands and premises are also hereby conveyed subject to such rights, easements and rights of way as heretofore have been granted unto or acquired by any public utility corporation, or political subdivision, in, upon and over said described premises or that in any way may affect said premises.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his (her or their) Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the said Ware Shoals Community Foundation, Inc., does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his (her or their) heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
