WHEREAS, Grace Cantrell

on or about the 20th day of April in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-four exhibited her  
complaint in the County Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against  
William Henry Cantrell, a minor

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the day of 19  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to James Daniel Cantrell  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said James Daniel Cantrell  
all the right, title and interest of the minor Defendant, William Henry  
Cantrell, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Bates Township, Green-  
ville County, State of South Carolina, known as part of the land conveyed  
to Wesley Cantrell by deed from Ludca Cantrell, adjoining lands of W. W.  
Childs, Wesley Cantrell, Ed Smith and the White Horse Road. Beginning on  
iron pin on said road thence running S. 67 W. 6.20 chains to a ditch, thence  
down ditch 9.10 to I. P. on said ditch thence S. 55 E. 9.00 to pine x3:  
thence N. 4 1/2 E. 4.68 to I. P.; thence N. 53 W. 80 links to I. P. on a  
ditch: thence N. 46 W. 1.72 bend; thence N. 37 1/2 W. 3.27 bend; thence N.  
1 1/2 W. 1.24 chains to bend; thence 15 E. 4.30 bend; thence N. 4 E. 2.70  
chains to the beginning corner and contains 7-3/4 acres, more or less."
