All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being a small triangular strip lying between the New Duncan Chapel Road, land of D. B. Tripp and land of John H. Bridwell (the Bridwell line having formerly been the center of the old Duncan Chapel Road), and having the following metes and bounds according to plat and survey by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March 1947:

BEGINNING at a stake on Duncan Chapel Road, D. B. Tripp's corner, and running thence with said road N. 32-30 W. 104 feet to stake at corner of John H. Bridwell's line; thence with Bridwell line (formerly old Duncan Chapel Road) S. 4-45 E. 149.5 feet to D. B. Tripp line; and thence with Tripp line N. 31-45 E. 67 feet to Duncan Chapel Road, the beginning corner.
