LEASE

This indenture made this day of July between B. B. O'SHIELDS, hereinafter called the Messor, and J. DONNALD DOBBINS, hereinafter called the lessee, WITNESSETH:

That the lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the lessee, and the lessee does accept, that certain parcel of land with brick store building located thereon, known as 619 E. North Street, in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, for a full term of five years, commencing on the day of fuly, 1954, and ending on the 1st day of fully 1959, yielding and paying therefor the sum of One Hundred (100.00) Dollars per month, payable on the first day of each month of said term. The lessee shall have the option to extend this lease for a further term of five years at the same rental and subject to all the terms and conditions of this lease, provided the lessee shall give written notice to the lessor of his election to take such extension not less than sixty days prior to the termination of the original term of this lease.

If any rent shall be due and unpaid, or if default shall be made of any of the covenants on the part of the lessee herein contained, it shall be lawful for the lessor to re-enter the premises and to have the same again, re-possess and enjoy.

And the lessee agrees that he shall pay the rent as herein specified, that he will not make any alterations in the structure of the building without written consent of the lessor, that he will not occupy or use, or permit to be occupied or used, the said premises for any business deemed extra hazardous on
