

 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James L. Duncan.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on Dukeland Drive, between Christopher Street and Greenville Street, in the Ethel L. Perry Subdivision, situate about three miles north of the City of Greenville, said lot being known and designated as Lot number two (2) or first of all property recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 31, the Plat to which is referred to and made a part hereof, and the said lot having the following lines, courses and distances:

Begun at an iron pin on the Northern side of Dukeland Drive, which pin is 230.8 feet west from the intersection of Christopher Street and Dukeland Drive, and running thence S. 9-1/2° 134.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots #2 and #4C; thence along Lanston Creek S. 77-12 E. 77 feet to another iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots #22 and #4C; thence S. 0-12 E. 117.0 feet to an iron pin on Dukeland Drive, joint front corner of Lots #2 and #4C; thence L. 39-28 E. 75 feet to a. iron pin, the point of beginning.

This property is in a restricted district, and no building is to be allowed on it, subject to the following restrictions, which shall be inserted in the conveyance, and shall be effective for twenty years from the date hereof:

- (1) Said property shall be used for residential purposes.
- (2) No residence shall be erected herein on a tract of land less than five thousand (.5,000.00) Dollars.
- (3) No building shall be erected herein within twenty-five (25) feet of the northern edge of the line of Dukeland Drive.
